



WMHA Rep Tournament Rules

1. All C.A.H.A. and N.O.H.A. rules will apply. Walden will appoint all officials. The tournament committee will deal with all major infractions.
2. Fighting, abusive language or intent to injure penalties will not be tolerated. O.H.F. suspension lists will be used. Additionally, the tournament committee will determine extra suspensions. Players or coaches could be suspended for the balance of the tournament.
3. All teams must be prepared to play fifteen (15) minutes prior to scheduled game times.
4. In the event of conflicting colours, the home team will be responsible for changing sweaters.
5. There will be body contact in the Pee wee division and above.
6. Warm ups shall consist of two minutes from the time the end doors are fully closed.
7. Ties in round robin play will remain a tie.
8. Point system: Win 2 points, Tie= 1 point each, Loss= 0 points.
9. If teams are tied after round robin play, the tie will be broken by:
 - a) Record between teams
 - b) The team with the most wins
 - c) The team with the best goal average (goals for divided goals for plus goals against)
 - d) The team that scored first goal in the game involving both teams
 - e) The least penalized team
 - f) A single coin toss.
10. All teams must register 1 hour prior to their first game. Cards and permits must be available at all Games.
11. All games will consist of three ten (10) minute, stop time periods.
12. If there is a four goal difference in the third period, running time will begin. Stop time will resume when the difference is reduced to three goals.
13. Overtime (sudden death), in semi – final games will consist of:
 - a) 5 on 5 for 5min,
 - b) 4 on 4 for 5 min
 - c) 3 on 3 for remaining time
 - d) If a penalty is called during 3 on 3 play, the player will serve two minutes in the penalty box , each team will add a player(would become 4 on 3). When the penalty expires the penalized player will enter the game until the next stoppage of play, then 3 on 3 will resume.
14. The tournament committee reserves the right to make decisions regarding interpretations of all Tournament rules and regulations.
15. Protests must be filed by team officials at the arena tournament office within one half hour of the end of the game. A \$ 250.00 fee must accompany the appeal, this money is non – refundable if the appeal is rejected. The decision of the tournament appeals committee will be final.
16. There will be no time outs permitted.
