

WMHA Player Release Policy

This policy is written as a standard to follow in handing out releases, and at the same time provides everyone with some insight on how to properly apply for a release.

The parents or players seeking a release must advise the appropriate convenor in writing.

- 1. Releases will be given without questions to anyone wanting to try out for a AAA or D.2 minor Elite team. They will first be released to the appropriate district 2 team.
- 2. Releases will be given without questions to anyone wanting to try out at their age group if it is not being offered and they don't have the opportunity to play-up within WMHA (see #3). They will be released to the closest district 2 team.
- 3. All other players seeking a release must first skate (tryout) in their own division before a release will be considered.
 - Any player who is eligible to play for a team offered by W.M.H.A. and failing to try out for said team will not be issued a release and will not be allowed to affiliate.
 - Any player deemed not fully participating in team tryouts will not be considered for a release from said team and will be asked to leave the tryouts.
 - Releases will be given to players trying out for a team and being unsuccessful. These
 releases will be issued at the players' request and are considered open, meaning the
 player can go tryout anywhere.
- 4. Releases are an annual process even for AAA players.
