



## WMHA Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct identifies the standard of behavior which is expected of all W.M.H.A. Members, including athletes, coaches, parents, directors, volunteers, staff, chaperones and others.

The W.M.H.A. is committed to providing a sport environment in which all individuals are treated with respect. Members of the W.M.H.A. shall conduct themselves at all times in a fair and responsible manner. Members shall refrain from comments or behaviors which are disrespectful, offensive, abusive, racist or sexist. In particular, behavior which constitutes harassment or abuse will not be tolerated by the W.M.H.A.

During the course of all W.M.H.A. activities and events, members shall avoid behavior which brings the W.M.H.A. or the sport of hockey into disrepute, including but not limited to abusive use of alcohol and non-medical use of drugs.

Members shall not use unlawful or unauthorized drugs/narcotics or performance enhancing drugs or methods.

OHF members shall at all times adhere to the OHF, Member Partners and Local Associations' operational policies and procedures, to rules governing the OHF, Member Partners and Local Associations' events and activities and to rules governing any competition in which the member participates on behalf of the OHF, Member Partners and Local Associations.

Members of the W.M.H.A., member Partners and Local Associations shall not engage in activity or behavior which endangers the safety of others.

Failure to comply with this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action, suspension or release from membership. Such action may result in the member losing privileges that come with membership in the OHF, Member Partners and Local Associations, including the opportunity to participate in W.M.H.A. activities.
