Attn: WMHA Coaches and Parent(s) or Guardian(s):

Each year WMHA receives a number of complaints and concerns about the punctuality and attendance of the players at games and practices. This has been an issue in the past years, but with the many changes and the countless hours that are put in by the volunteers each year, we are hoping that this will be a thing of the past.

F.Y.I. It is expected that ALL WMHA PLAYERS be ready to go on the ice prior to the zamboni beginning the re-surfacing. This means that your team expects you to be in the dressing room no less than 20 minutes prior to your scheduled ice time. Showing up when the zamboni is on the ice is an unacceptable practice. A lot of people volunteer a lot of time to give you the most for your dollar and to make sure things run smoothly.

Your child's coach requires this pre-game time to help develop these players into a team, which in turn helps to strengthen your association.

It is also important to note that ALL PLAYERS are expected to attend practices (even at 6:30 A.M.) This is a very important step toward your child's and the team's development. If you cannot attend it is expected that the coach be contacted with a valid reason.

Your coach does have the authority to enforce these rules with discipline should the problem continue.

We trust that we can expect your immediate and utmost co-operation with this matter.
